EVENT RECAP - DISTRICT CHAMPS

Red Thunder Robotics enjoyed their third consecutive trip to the FIM State Championship April 3-5. They, along with 39 other teams across they state, competed on the Hemlock Semiconductor field while the remaining 120 teams were split between Aptive, Consumer's Energy, or DTE fields.

The team finished qualifications ranked 5th with a record of 8-4-0. They served as the captain of the #3 alliance, choosing team 4391 Bravebots from Gladstone and 3322 Eagle Evolution from Ann Arbor.

Our alliance lost the first match of playoffs against alliance #6, which sent us to the lower bracket. We won the next four matches which brought us back to the finals to face the #1 alliance with team 67 HOT, whom we lost to in the finals of our first event.

We lost our first finals match but won the second match, sending us to yet again another tiebreaker match. Unfortunately, our alliance could not secure that win, resulting in being finalists on our field.
